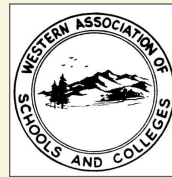

Catholic Identity

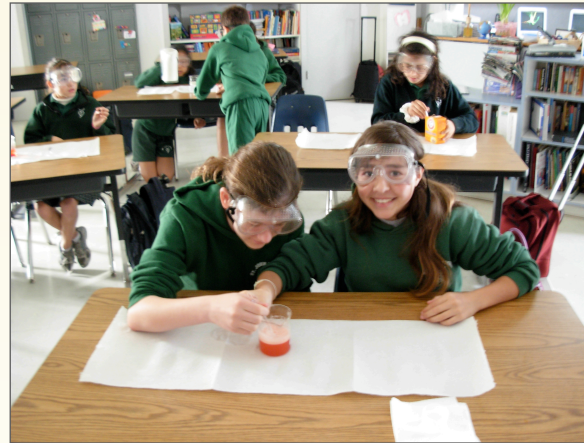
