

Signups in SchoolSpeak

- ▶ Easy to signup all in a single Application
 - ▶ Don't have to log into many different applications
- ▶ Coordinators may view the assignees within SchoolSpeak
- SchoolSpeak administrators can manage permissions easily
- Use the goal tracker to track time volunteered, dollars donated or scrip purchased
 - ▶ Parents can see where they are as the year progresses

Signup Resources

Task based sign ups

Good for:

- Committee signupsDonations for parties,
- events, classrooms
- Group signups
- Tasks

Volunteer Calendar

Date and time based signups

- Good for:
 Yard/lunch signups
- Class time volunteer
- opportunities
- Parties and events -time
- slots
- Parent teacher conferences

Valuable Sign Up Resource Options

- ► Email reminders to assignees
- ► Email notifications
- Locking signups to prevent members from adding/changing times
- ▶ Enable substitutes for certain signups



Volunteer Calendar Resource Options

- ▶ Lock Period Days before event that signup should lock
 - ▶ Allows parents to change signup until that time
 - ▶ 2 or 3 days is a good number
- ▶ Allow signup for events to Date sign up ends!
 - ▶ Last day of activity or day after
 - ▶ Allows you to open a subset of signups during a longer period
 - Example Yard duty times are setup for the year but parents signup by term
- ► Allow substitutes No/Yes
- ▶ Enable Email reminder Yes*/No
- ► Enable Email notification Yes/No

Typical Settings options

- ► Show who has signed up refers to the list on the signup page
 - ► No if want list private
 - ▶ Yes if list can be public
- Show assignees on home page refers to group homepage where located
 - $\,\blacktriangleright\,$ No If list of who has signed up should be private
 - ➤ Yes if list can be made public then choose options
- ► Show slot capacity column Yes*/No
- ► Slot capacity column name Make relatable
- ► Show open#? Yes*/No

Using Categories Vol Cal, Signup, Goal Tracking

- Categories
 - Using Categories make it easy for a parent to sign up for specific kinds of events
 - ▶ When used in Volunteer Calendar allows admins to track the kinds of hours that were used
 - ▶ When using the goal tracker can use same categories as the volunteer calendar

Sign Up Resource Options

- ▶ Start Date Start of signup
- ▶ Lock Date- Date when signup is locked
- ▶ End Date Date when signup is closed
- ▶ Display Items on homepage Yes/No
- ▶ Allow substitution No/Yes
- ▶ Show who has signed up No/Yes
- ▶ Enable Email notification Yes/No
- ▶ \Show slot capacity column Yes/No
- ▶ Slot capacity column name Customize per use
- ► Show open # Yes*/No

Goal Tracking

- ▶ Track time, count or amount
- ► Can sync with volunteer calendars
 - ▶ Optional Add Goal tracking first so that can sync when creating a new vol calendar
- ▶ View by member or family
- Uses:
 - Service hours
 - ▶ Donations to school
 - Scrip purchases

Parent Teacher Conference Signup

- ▶ Resource = Volunteer Calendar
- ► Location Options
 - ▶ Grade level for conference with homeroom teacher
 - ► Homeroom teachers teaches all basic subjects
 - ▶ School Group if allowing parents to see all of the conference signups
 - + See all of signups
 - ▶ Adds a lot of items to your school homepage
 - ▶ Create a new group called Parent Teacher Conferences
 - + Good for middle school environment/sectioned classes where a parent may need to speak with more than one teacher
 - +Can have all grades included
 - ► +Can modify the permission for that resource so that only grade appropriate parents can sign up

Offline/Online

- While setting up the conferences use the resources setting Offline/Online to hide it from parents until you are ready
 - ► Resource Admin → Offline or Online
 - ▶ Offline Parents not able to see the resource
 - ▶ Online Parents can see resource
 - ▶ Create the resource and make it offline
 - ▶ When ready for signup change the field to *online*
 - When conferences are complete make the resource offline or hide the link and content under the group admin page
 - ▶ If using a PTC group View -ADMIN until ready

How to add the resources to multiple groups

- ► Can add individually to each groups
 - ▶ Grade 1,2,3...
- Make one copy within the Parent Conference group
 - ► Name Example Grade 1, Mrs. Brown
 - ► Set View to Grade level group
 - ▶ Set Edit to teacher
 - ▶ Set all settings
 - Make entries for the conferences
 - Make extra Vol calendars
 - ► (May contact support to make copies of original setup)
 - ▶ Can also copy entries from first set conference sign up to others
 - ▶ Can reuse from last year and copy forward

Resource Options

- ▶ Typical settings for Parent teacher conferences
 - ▶ Lock Period Days before event that signup should lock
 - ▶ 2 or 3 days
 - ▶ Allow signup for events to Date sign up ends
 - Last day of conference or day after
 - ▶ Allow substitutes No
 - ► Enable Email reminder Yes
 - ► Enable Email notification No

Typical Settings options

- ► Show who has signed up -
 - ▶ No if want list private
 - ➤ Yes if list can be public
- ▶ Show assignees on home page
 - ▶ No If list of who has signed up should be private
 - ▶ Yes if list can be made public
- ▶ Show slot capacity column Yes
- ▶ Slot capacity column name "family"
- ▶ Show open#? Yes

Adding Time Slots to the Parent Teacher conference resource • Add/Modify Entries • Start date - Start date for an individual conference time slot • End Date - Leave Blank • Start time/End Time - Time for the individual conference • Number of Signups - 1 (if used family as slot name) • Notes - May put in Conference or leave blink since this resource is dedicated to parent teacher conferences • Status - Open • Click Add when done • Add additional time slots for appropriate days
