## REFLECTING SUNDAY'S GOSPEL MESSAGE



### Rejoice Sunday

John 1:6-8,23-28

#### Reflecting on the Word

Today is Gaudete Sunday. We are so close to the birth of Jesus, we begin to rejoice! We light the rose-colored candle on the Advent wreath, reminding us of that joy. Once again, we encounter John the Baptist, who acknowledged that he is not the light (the Messiah), but that he came to testify to the light so that many would believe through him. We are also called to reflect the light of Christ by our words and actions. Though we are unworthy, as John was, we are called to be light to each other in all that we say and do.

#### .....ON THE WAY TO MASS

Christmas is coming closer. Ask your family to observe what signs at Mass tell us that Christmas is near.

#### ON THE WAY HOME FROM MASS.....

Why is Jesus described as "the light"?

#### Living the Word

Help your children carefully and safely place a lit candle in front of a mirror. Notice and discuss the differences between the actual light and the light in the reflection. Write a list of Jesus' qualities and actions. Then make a list of how you could reflect those same qualities and imitate those actions. Near the end of the week, have your children draw a side profile of themselves facing Jesus. How can we reflect and follow Jesus in our lives?
