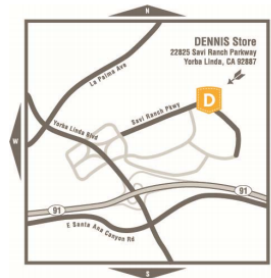

Reflecting on the Word

On Palm Sunday, we are reminded of how Jesus triumphantly returned to Jerusalem. In today's liturgy, we also process into church, holding palms and singing. This is a celebratory reception filled with praise, adoration, and great joy. Jesus' welcome into the city was in stark contrast to what will take place on Good Friday.

Leave small slips of paper on your prayer table and invite family members to write something they hope for on one side of the slip, and then something they fear on the other side. Encourage them to write on the slips for the entire week. On Saturday night, when the Easter fire is lighted, burn these papers to symbolize that your family is giving these hopes and fears over to God.
