Reflecting on the Word

On Palm Sunday, we are reminded of how Jesus triumphantly returned to Jerusalem. In today's liturgy, we also process into church, holding palms and singing. This is a celebratory reception filled with praise, adoration, and great joy. Jesus' welcome into the into the city was in stark contrast to what will take place on Good Friday.

On Saturday night, when the Easter fire is lighted, burn these papers to symbolize that your family is giving these hopes and fears over to God.
