



## 2018-19 Uniform Guidelines

**Every Tuesday will be a Dress Uniform Day for All-School Mass!**

### BOYS

- Junior Kindergarten (formerly PreK) - 5th
  - Regular
    - Dark green, kelly green, or white polo with logo, tucked in
    - Khaki pant or shorts
    - Brown or black belt (not required for JK or K)
    - SGGS hoodie or fleece (if cold in class)
    - Only plain white ankle- or crew-length athletic socks
    - Black or brown rubber soled shoes, or sneakers
  - Dress
    - White, long- or short-sleeved oxford shirt, tucked in
    - Khaki pants
    - Brown or black belt (not required for JK or K)
    - Plaid tie
    - Green sweater with logo, optional
    - Tan dress socks
    - Black or brown dress leather or leather-like shoes
- 6th - 8th
  - Regular
    - Dark green, kelly green, or white polo with logo, tucked in
    - Khaki pant or shorts
    - No tights or leggings with shorts
    - SGGS hoodie or fleece (if cold in class)
    - Only plain white ankle- or crew-length athletic socks
    - Black or brown rubber soled shoes, or sneakers
  - Dress
    - White, long-sleeved oxford shirt, tucked in
    - Khaki pants with belt
    - Striped tie
    - Green vest with logo
    - Tan dress socks
    - Black or brown dress leather or leather-like shoes

### BOYS and GIRLS PE UNIFORM

- Junior Kindergarten (formerly PreK) - 5th
  - Gray PE shirt (no SGGS spiritwear shirts)
  - Green PE shorts or sweatpants with logo
  - Only plain white athletic socks, no tights or leggings with shorts
  - Sneakers, no wheels or lights
  - Green sweatshirt with logo



- 6th - 8th
  - Gray PE shirt (no SGGS spiritwear shirts)
  - SGGS Athletic dri-fit t-shirt
  - Green PE shorts or sweatpants with logo
  - Only plain white athletic socks, no tights or leggings with shorts
  - Sneakers, no wheels or lights
  - Green sweatshirt with logo

## **GIRLS**

- Junior Kindergarten (formerly PreK) - 5th
  - Regular
    - Dark green, kelly green, or white polo with logo, tucked in
    - Khaki pant; shorts or skorts (*no more than 2" above the knee*)
    - No tights or leggings with shorts
    - SGGS hoodie or fleece (if cold in class)
    - Only plain white ankle- or crew-length athletic socks, or green knee-high or green tights, with rubber-soled shoes, or sneakers
  - Dress
    - Plaid jumper
    - White, long- or short-sleeved Peter Pan collared shirt
    - Green cardigan with logo, optional
    - Green knee-highs or tights
    - Black or brown leather or leather-like dress shoes
- 6th - 8th
  - Regular
    - Dark green, kelly green, or white polo with logo, tucked in
    - Khaki pant; shorts or skorts (*no more than 2" above the knee*)
    - No tights or leggings with shorts
    - SGGS hoodie or fleece (if cold in class)
    - Only plain white ankle- or crew-length athletic socks, or green knee-high or green tights, with rubber-soled shoes, or sneakers
  - Dress
    - White, long-sleeved oxford shirt, tucked in
    - Sullivan Hall plaid skirt, no more than 2" above the knee
    - Striped tie
    - Green vest with logo
    - Green knee-highs or tights
    - Black or brown leather or leather-like dress shoes

## **UNIFORM GUIDELINES**

- Please note that the uniform dress code applies regardless of season.
- Shirts are to be tucked in for BOTH regular and dress uniform.
- Skinny-cut pants or shorts are not acceptable.
- Polo shirts with the SGGS logo that are not green or white are no longer part of the uniform dress code.



- The old 2016-17 plaid skirt for middle school girls will no longer be worn in Sullivan Hall.
- Sneakers are no longer required to be mostly white or mostly black. The only restriction is that shoes must be close-toed, with no wheels nor lights.
- Shorts skort length must be *no more than 2" above the knee*.
- Sneakers may be worn with the regular uniform.
- No boots or ankle boots allowed.
- There are *no more crazy socks allowed* unless for a designated Crazy Sock Spirit Day. Uniform socks are required as defined above.
- Parents will be notified same day if a student is out of uniform and needs a change of clothing to be brought to school.

### **BOYS PERSONAL APPEARANCE**

- Faded or worn uniforms need to be replaced.
- Boys' hair and fingernails should be neatly trimmed.
- Hair must not touch the collar, or be below eyebrows in front, and must be trimmed around the ears.
- No "tails" or outlandish hairstyles. Dyed or colored hair is not permitted; the student's natural hair color is expected. Appropriateness of hair will be determined by the Administration or Advancement team.
- Students will be given a warning with one week to make necessary changes. Boys who need to shave should be cleanly shaven at all times.
- Earrings or any sort of tattoo is strictly forbidden. Religious medals or crucifixes on a small chain may be worn. Bracelets are not permitted.
- For safety and security, no jewelry may be worn on PE days.
- Hair scarves/do-rags are not acceptable.

### **GIRLS PERSONAL APPEARANCE**

- Faded or worn uniforms need to be replaced.
- If girls choose to wear the plaid jumper or skirt, the full dress uniform code applies.
- Make-up is not allowed including lipstick, blush, and eye make-up. Light foundation or powder only.
- Tattoos are strictly forbidden.
- Modest post-type earrings only may be worn, one earring per ear. One ring, one bracelet may be worn. Religious medals or crucifixes on a small chain may be worn. For safety and security, no jewelry may be worn on PE days.
- Fingernails are to be neatly trimmed; clear nail polish only is acceptable. No gel or acrylic nails.
- Conservative hairstyle is expected; dyed, colored, or dipped hair is not permitted; the student's natural hair color only is expected.
- Appropriateness of hairstyle or color will be determined by the Administration or Advancement Team. Students will be given a warning with one week to make needed changes.
- Hair scarves are not acceptable.



- SGGS plaid headbands and scrungies only are allowed. Plain green or black elastics may be worn to hold hair back.
- Headbands with attached accessories are not allowed (cat ears, bunny ears, etc.).

### **DRESS DOWN GUIDELINES FOR JK - GRADE 8**

- Pants must be appropriate fitting. They should be neat and without any holes. Leggings are not acceptable unless covered by appropriate length skirt, dress, or shorts.
- Consistent with uniform policy, skirts/skort/shorts must be *no more than 2" above the knee*.
- Shirts must have sleeves and may not have any inappropriate logos, pictures, or symbols. No tank tops, tops showing cleavage, spaghetti straps, bare midriff, or bare shoulder tops may be worn.
- For Safety Reasons:
  - No dangling earrings
  - No platform shoes, flip flops, or sandals
- Parents will be notified to bring a change of clothes if a student comes to school dressed inappropriately.
- These guidelines also apply to after school-sponsored functions, such as middle school dances.
